Insurers on the Frontlines

Insurers mobilized immediately after the wildfires to help families begin recovering, not just by paying claims, but by providing emergency assistance and on-ground support. From the earliest days of the disaster, insurers:

- Helped families secure emergency housing, food, clothing, and immediate financial assistance
- Established Recovery Help Centers in Pasadena and the Pacific Palisades
- Proactively contacted affected policyholders to begin the claims process
- Deployed catastrophe response teams and claims professionals to impacted communities
- Continue working with homeowners and businesses throughout the rebuilding process
